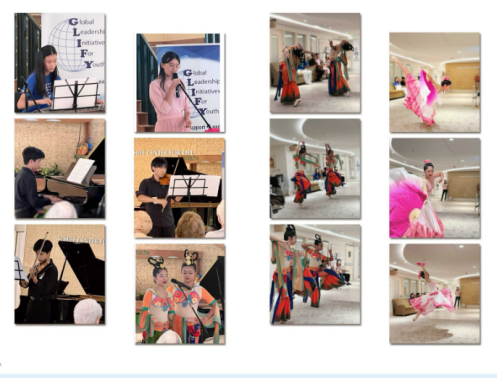

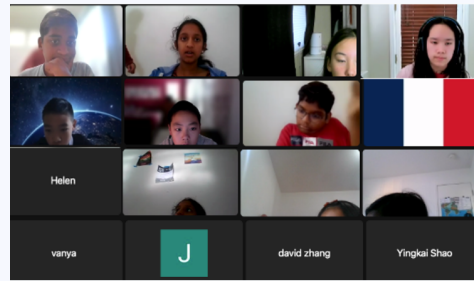


Reutinger Senior Center Performance

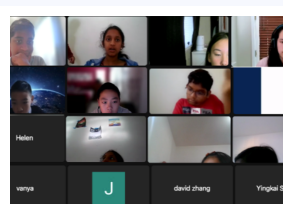
